It's as if the Russian-born Canadian is echoing the late Toronto native Neil Peart from RUSH's 1978 *Hemispheres:* "Sensibility, armed with Sense & Liberty, with the Heart & Mind United in a single, perfect Sphere" is what characterizes Purpose-Driven solidarity and achievement.

If you don't yet understand the powerful world of decentralized autonomous computing and the permanent value of cryptocurrency safely encoded on a blockchain, so what?

Buterin gets you up-to-speed on what matters most: the venerable purposes driving the world's leading program in the rapidly emerging space that really is here to stay.

It is impossible to come away from 'PROOF OF STAKE' unchanged because the possibilities it anchors to reality are even richer in moral wealth than the fountain of material prosperity that is already springing up inevitably to those with the wisdom and courage to love enough to give it away.
